

Cross-domain discussion platform driving standardizations in the area of automated driving



- vehicles Safety for automated driving systems Design, verification and validation >> under development


OADF ongoing work

Ecosystem TF

- Functional architecture proposed by BMW
- Review of the ecosystem

Continuous interaction between the different member organisations

- identifying gaps, overlaps between each others activity areas
- helping better understanding the map relevant AD requirements
- bringing AD related standardisation closer to the industry stakeholders (standardisation not any more a boring, slowly advancing work)
- fostering the intention of external organisations to approach OADF for consultation and collaboration, positioning it as an expert platform
- Continuous and extended mapping of the AD standardisation ecosystem started
